



Admissions Policy

Denham Village School is a one form entry primary school for children aged 4 to 11.

We offer 15 places each year to our Reception class from beyond our specified catchment area. We currently offer a single form Year 1 class (2019/20 only) and combined class for children in Year 3 and 4. Following a successful period of consultation have become a Primary school offering provision to children up to age 11 in Year 6 from 2021. Usual class structure once fully established will be Reception, combined Y1/2, combined Y3/4 and combined Y5/6.

The children are all admitted into Reception class from September in a full time capacity.

The Headteacher offers regular tours of the school for prospective parents, by appointment.

Denham Village School adheres to Bucks County Council admissions policy:-

- All admissions are dealt with by the admissions team at County.
- The County Council manage school waiting lists.
- Denham Village School offers school places through the County admissions team, not directly.
- Any child admitted by County will be invited to join the class for an introduction session whenever possible, before their starting date.
- All admission forms must be completed by the parents on or before the admission date.
- Office staff will be available to liaise with parents concerning uniform.
