



# School Admissions





Denham Village School is changing to become an all through school with an admission number of 15 from 2019. The School currently have a Year 3 class and in September 2019 they will become Year 4.

We plan to offer 15 places each year to our Reception class, mostly from our catchment area.

The children are normally admitted into Reception class from September, with 2 half day sessions before they start full time. This ensures that children have time to adapt to the school routine but quickly settle into a full school day. However, if parents need their child to start full time from the beginning they can do so - please contact the Headteacher.

The Headteacher offers parents individual tours of the school in the Autumn term.

Denham Village School is a community school and follows Buckinghamshire County Council's admissions policy: -

- All admissions are dealt with by the Admissions and Transport Team.
- The Admissions and Transport Team hold waiting and continuing interest lists.
- The school will liaise with the Admissions and Transport Team who will make all offers of places on behalf of the governing body.
- Any child offered a place will be invited to join the class for half a day before the starting date.
- All admission forms must be completed by the parents on or before the admission date.
- Office staff will be available to liaise with parents concerning uniform.
