

## Year 4 Snow Day Work

Wrap up warm and go outside to enjoy the snow (let your parents/ carers know):

- Make a snowman (what could you use for their eyes, mouth and arms?)
- What resources could you use to make some outside winter art?
- Set up an investigation to see what makes snow melt.

When it gets too cold, go back inside:

- What healthy food or drink choices help you warm up and feel comfortable again?
- Winter art – draw or paint a winter scene. It could be the view from your window. What colours can you use?
- Write about a trip into a snowy land. How did it feel as you walked trekked across the snow? What person or creature do you meet on your journey (a snowman or snow creature?). Write the conversation you have with them using speech punctuation.
- 12 days of Christmas maths investigation. In the 12 days of Christmas, the singer gives their true love lots of presents.

Day 1 – a partridge in a pear tree

Day 2 – 2 turtle doves and a partridge in a pear tree

Day 3 – 3 french hens, 2 turtle doves and a partridge in a pear tree

First challenge – Add up how many presents on each day: first day=1, second day=1+2, third day=1+2+3. Can you work it out to day 12?

Extra challenge – how many presents does that make in total? You will have to add up the presents on the first day to those on the 2 nd day, 3 rd ,.... All the way to the 12th!
