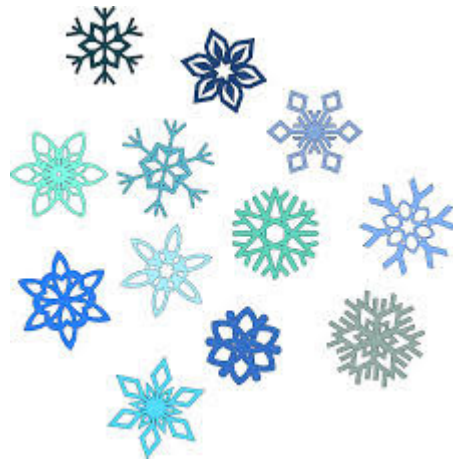


Year 1 Snow Work Pack

2. Make sure there's the same amount of snow in each container.
3. Put the containers in different places around your home.
4. Time how long it takes the snow in each container to melt.
5. Why do you think some snow melted more quickly than other snow?

Continue to learn number bonds to 10

Make up some snowy word problems to go with a number sentence.

Eg $10 + 4 = 14$ There are 10 snowmen and if I build 4 more I will have 14 altogether. $15 - 3 = 12$ I have 15 snowflakes and if 3 of them melt I will be left with 12 snowflakes.
